### **Welcome** (Ric)

### **Disney Trip** (Dunlop)

-*New date* The Disney trip will be moved to the same time next year, around Memorial Day 2021. If some seniors still would really like to join us, we will open it up to them in March, depending on available spots. Hopefully this date will give us the best chance to still make the trip happen since this summer and fall are still uncertain.

-*Senior refunds.* We have been able to get all of our deposits back from the hotels, bus company, etc. We will be offering a full refund to seniors who do not still owe fees. We can not give back fundraising money because of non-profit rules. The treasurers are working their way through all of the seniors individually. Any money that can not be refunded can be moved down to younger siblings, friends, or our general scholarship fund to cover next year's fees. Liz and Monica will be contacting all seniors soon to discuss options.

-*General refunds.* Non-seniors will have the option to keep the money where it is to cover next year's fees. If you want/need a refund, you will need to let us know and we will process that after we have made it through the senior's accounts. If we don't hear from you, we will assume that you want the money left in your account to cover next year's fees.

### **Communication** (Dunlop ,Layna Beale)

Communication has gotten trickier but we are doing our best to get information out. We are working now to get out info for drum major try outs. Section leader applications will be happening soon. Officer elections for next year are also coming up.

We are working on putting together a virtual award night for everyone. We will share that information when we have it.

We can do that before our next parent meeting so that there can be discussion before we vote on it. The proposed budget for next year will send it out ahead of next month's parent meeting. Many families have completed all of their volunteer hours for the year. Vanessa has sent a report to the treasurers so your statement should be up to date when the next ones are sent out. Statements could take a while to go out because the treasurers are still trying to get DL sorted out. A lot of families are running out of space to store cans and bottles that they are saving for us. Is there a space to store them? Mr Dunlop will look into finding a place to store them and how we can set up a drop off.

Mr Dunlop is calling all of the incoming freshmen to get emails and contact information. He will send a letter to each of them and the band officers and section leaders will contact them. We may put together a welcome video. We want them to feel welcome and that we are excited to have them!

As of now, HAS/Camp Amp is still happening. Mr Dunlop will let us all know if there are changes.

Dates for band camp and competitions for the summer and fall have been updated on the calendar. Keep in mind that a lot can happen between now and then and things may change. Championships will be at OSU on Halloween. We are looking into traveling to a competition the weekend after championships.
