Board Meeting
5/2020

- Elections (bylaws?): Bylaws are clear that board positions can not be shared. People can help and be in the boosters club without a student in the band but they can not have a vote. Maybe we should clear up the wording in the bylaws in the fall.
 - We should plan to ask at the parent meeting for volunteers to cover food for next year.
- Marching band: The first night went great. There were about 20 seniors there. Also about 20 8th graders and freshmen. Section leaders have been reaching out to freshmen to encourage them to come try it out. The percussion group is also going great.
 - Street signs going out tomorrow for the color guard to try and recruit for the next 2 Tuesdays.
 - Seniors want to be pinned at the June 19th show.
 - They also want to have a water balloon fight. (June 15th)
 - Skits and pie eating contest, dress up days
 - Want to wear their uniforms for their performance on 6/19.
- CHOMP concert: The concert will premiere on the youtube channel tomorrow at 8:00, after the color guard premiere. Mr Dunlop will send out invitations today. The students needed extra time to get their videos turned in.
- Color Guard Showcase: This will happen tomorrow at 7 pm. The link is on the website.
- After school groups:
 - Mondays: Jazz band w/Mr Carr.
 - Reading sessions/come play music once a week starting next week.
 - Also, the middle schools will have beginning, intermediate and advanced bands next year. They are adding an extra class to give students another elective option for next year.
- Graduation: There was a meeting today about graduation. The band will play for the in person and not drive thru option.
- Virtual 5K: Mr Dunlop has bibs and medals. He has talked to Portland Road Racers and they are excited. It is looking like it will get pushed into early fall. Things are just taking longer than expected to get it all together.
- Fundraising:
 - The flowers were great. We sold quite a few baskets and they looked great.

- The can drive truck is almost full. It will need to be emptied after the next one. That is ~\$7000-\$8000 worth of cans. Students can help with the next can drive. They can't go door to door, but they can be there and help sort.
 - We need to start thinking about the fireworks stand. We will be at Walmart again. Mr Dunlop has been in contact with them and has been making the arrangements. We will plan to have the fireworks delivered 6/28 and sell through 7/4.
- Treasurer's report:
 - One parent wanted to make a payment through the website but the option is gone. Can we set it up for people to pay as much as they want and not just \$100 at a time? Jeff will talk to Mike and figure it out.
 - Some seniors have asked for their Disney money back and some have donated it to the band.
 - We should work on creating a formal application for scholarships.
 - ~\$975/person for the Disney trip. Mr Dunlop will talk about that at next week's parent meeting. It could be less if we can put 4 kids per room. This price includes flying instead of busses and a trip to Medieval Times, and 2 performances at DisneyLand.
 - We are looking at May 19-23
- Volunteers:
 - We will need volunteers for the can drive and water balloon fight. We also need to start organizing for the run in the fall.
 - May 22, one last SPARK meeting, bingo night. We would deliver bags to students' houses who do not pick them up at the marching band practice on the Tuesday before. Deliver 19-21.
