3/2/21

- CHOMP
There are about 41 students signed up for CHOMP. Everyone is doing great. Moving online is not ideal but people are still learning and having a good time which are the goals.

- Winter winds virtual competitions
All of the winter groups have a possibility of moving indoors. Some sports have moved indoors. There will be a google form for families to fill out to see how they feel about moving indoors. We are looking for space now. We will need to get going on costumes and a floor soon. If we can move indoors, we might have a different plan so we need to get that decided first.

- Fundraisers
 - Virtual 5K
The website and the art will be ready shortly after we decide on a name. Dunlop is proposing Bandwidth (Bandwidth, with a note for the second d).

If we can make ~\$20,000 off of this fundraiser, the budget will be in a really good place at the start of next year. Then we can focus more on rebuilding and less on fundraising.

Mr Dunlop is thinking that we should charge \$30/person to sign up. Our costs will be ~\$8/person. We would charge \$12/person for other schools, plus shipping to send them materials. They would charge their participants \$30 each and keep the profit. We will make the medals ourselves at Century. Mr Loun is ok with us using the school's 3-D printers for that. We can also print the t-shirts ourselves. Bibs are only 22 cents each if we order 1000 at a time. We will need to order ribbons. They will take a week and are ~97 cents each. There will be no expense for setting up a website. We would make ~\$4/person for each of the other schools that participate and ~\$22/person that we sign up ourselves.

Dunlop is talking to Parks and Rec about helping us set up a finish line for a day some time near in the last couple of weeks in May. Bands probably need a month or so to sign up and get back to us. We would like to finish the database mid-March.
