- Spring marching band

Freshmen and 8th graders started on 5/4. This Thursday will be the start for the rest of the students. We had a good start with the freshmen and 8th graders last week. This is a great way to give the seniors a performance and give them a chance to help teach the younger students. It also helps get younger students ready for fall. The music is all online on the band website. We are still recruiting and taking more students. Please help get the word out.

- Graduation

There will be live and drive-thru options for graduation this year. We will play for the live option (the Monday jazz group). Seniors can perform with the jazz band if they want to.

- Disneyland

We are planning a trip to Disneyland May 19-23. We will fly down on Thursday. 2 performances in 3 days in Disneyland. We plan to stay at a hotel close enough to walk back and forth to DL (~½ mile). We would also visit the Medieval Times restaurant on Thursday night. Friday we plan to go to DL and do a clinic and recording. Saturday or Sunday we will do a parade (we are waiting to hear). On the 3rd day we will not perform but have fun in the park. We would fly home on Monday. Mr Dunlop has tentatively cleared the days with the school. There will be no AP test conflicts. This plan would cost ~\$975/person. This is more than our trip that was planned before COVID but includes food, admission to park, flight, etc. A contract will go up online so that we can start getting an idea of who plans to go. We would love for parents to come as a chaperone. Families can also join us. In the past, some families have driven down or traveled separately and met us there.

- Virtual 5K

Everything is ready but we haven't had time to get it rolling. We decided to move it to the fall so that we have time to get other schools involved and do it the right way without rushing it.

We can find one if you need it. We have enough people to cover the minimum requirement but we can always take more to cover more shifts. - Plant sale went great.

- June 28-July 4 - fireworks stand. This will be our first big fundraiser for next year. Will be restarting fundraising points for next year. We are looking for a parent who is interested in running the fireworks stand.
- We received a check from FM for \$452 for the quarter.

- Treasurer's report

Nothing new. If you work for Nike or Intel, you can put your hours in to get the band money, even the parent meeting counts. We have had some good fundraisers and donations this year, so the band is in good shape financially.

- Volunteers

- Can drive: We really need parents to come and help with the can drive. A signup was sent out.
- Deliver bingo bags. We need drivers to make some deliveries to students. The students want to play virtual bingo so we are putting together a bag with snacks, bingo card, crayon. We will hand them out at Spring marching band but not everyone will be there. We need people to help drop them off at the door to others.
- Water balloon fight? The seniors would really like to continue some of our usually marching band traditions during spring marching. They want to be pinned on June 19. They want to have skits at Spring marching, wear uniforms for their 6/19 performance, and have a water balloon fight. Student leaders are working on how to make a water balloon fight work with social distancing. We will need help filling balloons and setting them up.
- Food committee for next year. We would like for people to start thinking about volunteering to help put a food committee together for next year.
